“ March 4 , 2022 my husband, Jerry, suffered an Ischemic stroke during surgery to repair a dissection in his descending aorta. We knew the odds to come out of the surgery unscathed were against him, but at the same time we thought “surely this will not happen to Jerry”. To say the least our lives were changed forever. We were devastated when the doctors told us his condition and had no idea what the next steps should be.

Jerry started therapy as soon as he could. Improvements could be seen daily, however after a couple of months he needed and wanted more.
