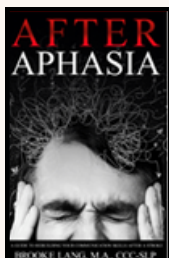


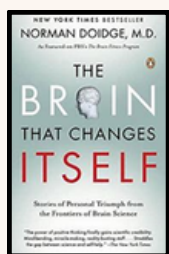

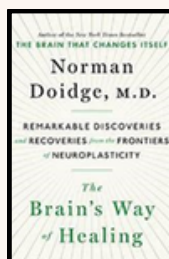
After Aphasia By Brooke Lang, M.A., CCC-SLP

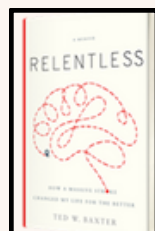
The Brain That Changes Itself By Norman Doidge, M. D.

Ted Baxter, a successful businessman and stroke survivor, tells his story of his incredible determination and recovery



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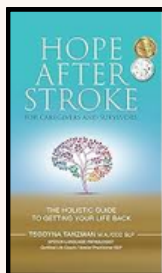
Alphi, The Dog with Special Aphasia Powers By Gail Weissman, MS MA CCC-SLP

The book is designed to educate family members of stroke survivors on how to communicate best with loved ones who have aphasia.



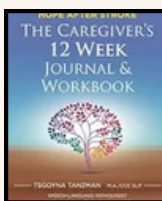
Stroke: The Best Thing That Happened By Bill Gasiamis

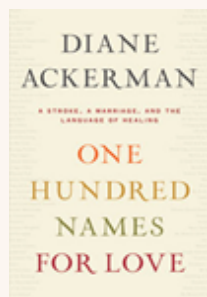
The Caregivers 12 Week Journal and Workbook By Tsgoyna Tansman

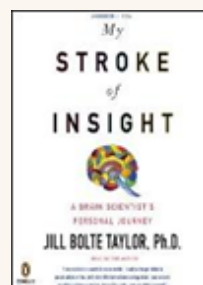

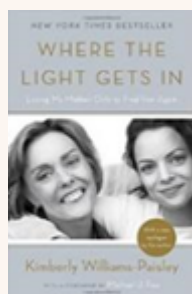
